About ECART

The Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ECART) is the ethics committee for the purposes of the Human Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2004 ([the HART Act](#)), which aims to secure the benefits of these technologies by promoting and protecting the health, safety, dignity and rights of those involved in them.

Under the HART Act, ECART's prior approval is required in order to conduct:

- human reproductive research (that is, research that involves the creation or use of human gametes, human embryos or hybrid embryos)
- assisted reproductive procedures, except those that have been declared to be 'established procedures'.

ECART reviews applications for human reproductive research and assisted reproductive procedures in accordance with guidelines issued by the Advisory Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ACART).

Purpose of this report

ECART's [Terms of Reference](#) require it to report annually to the Minister of Health.

This report must include information on ECART's membership, a summary of the applications reviewed during the year, details of any complaints received (and how they were resolved), and areas of review that caused difficulty in making decisions. The report should also detail the number and type of applications for assisted reproductive procedures and human reproductive research, the date of first review, the final outcome, and the reason for the deferring or declining of any applications.

Chairperson's report

I am pleased to present the 19th Annual Report of the Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ECART), for the year ending 30 June 2024.

Applications

In 2023/2024 ECART reviewed 60 applications over six meetings; compared with the 2022/2023 year when ECART reviewed 66 applications over six meetings. ECART also reviewed 166 applications to extend the storage period of gametes and embryos beyond their original 10/year limit.

ACART guidelines

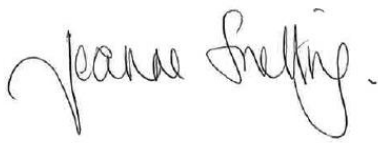
In 2023/2024 ACART published revised guidelines for posthumous reproduction and revised guidelines for extending the storage of human gametes and embryos.

Additional function

Following a request from fertility clinics to be able to approach ECART for informal advice on established procedures, ECART wrote to the Minister of Health asking for this function to be assigned pursuant to section 28(1)(e) of the HART Act. The Minister agreed to assign this function to ECART and asked for details of such advice to be included in future Annual Reports; these details can be found on page 18 of this report.

Applications reviewed

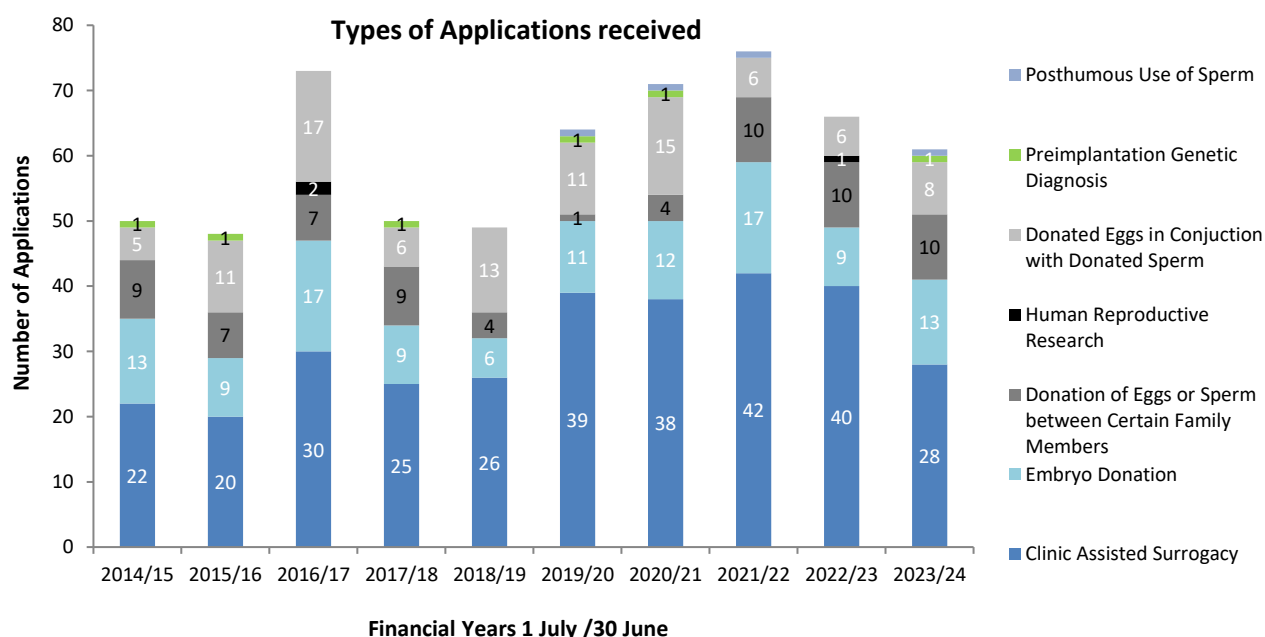
ECART reviewed 60 applications in 2023/2024. Of the 60 applications considered, there were:

- 28 applications for surrogacy arrangements involving providers of fertility services,
- 10 applications for donation of eggs/sperm between certain family members (including one extension to a previously approved application),
- 13 applications for embryo donation (including one extension),
- 8 applications for donated eggs in conjunction with donated sperm (including two extensions),
- 1 application for posthumous use of sperm (reconsideration of a previously declined application).

Between 1 July 2023 and 30 June 2024, ECART considered:

- 1 request for non-binding ethical advice on transfer of embryos known to be affected by an autosomal dominant condition following preimplantation genetic testing (PGT/M) that was performed to identify healthy embryos for transfer.

In the reporting period 2023/24, of the 60 assisted reproductive procedure applications reviewed in 2023/2024, 28 were approved at first review, seven were approved subject to conditions, 20 were approved with recommendations, five were deferred and one was declined.

Of the five deferred applications, four were approved on second review and one had no outcome as of 1 July 2024.

This year, ECART also considered 166 applications for extension of storage. Details can be found on page 19 of this report. In the previous reporting year ECART considered 128 applications for extended storage of gametes and embryos.

The following sections in this report indicate the number of recorded live births from approved ECART applications by reporting year. Creation and use, for reproductive purposes, of an embryo from donated eggs with donated sperm

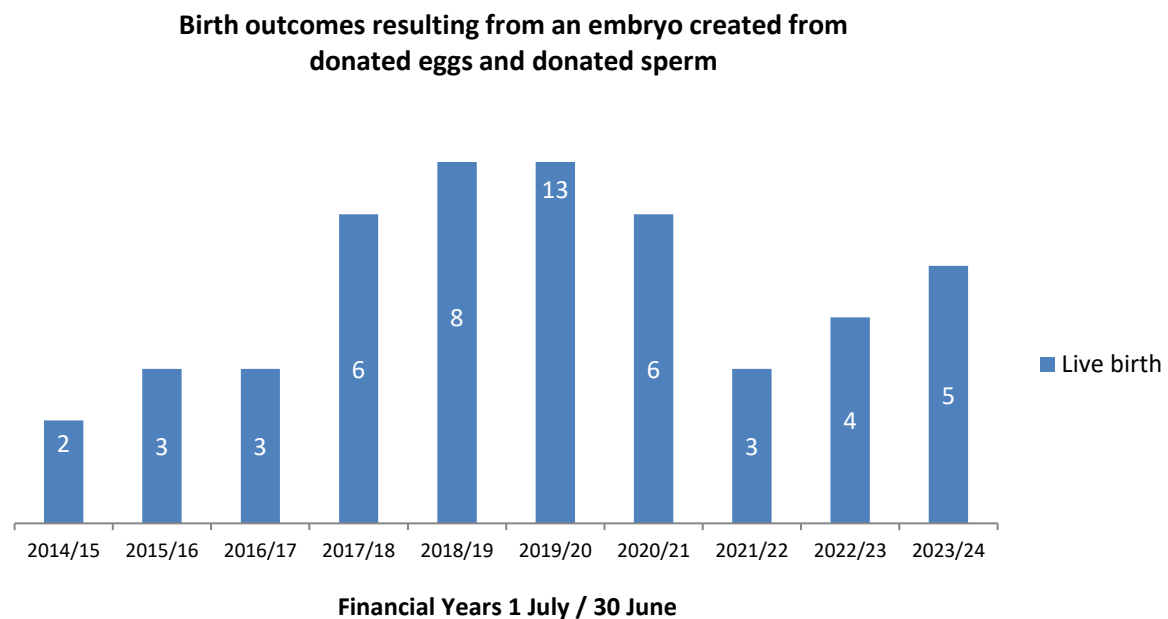
In 2023/2024, ECART reviewed eight applications for the creation and use, for reproductive purposes, of an embryo created from donated eggs in conjunction with donated sperm. ECART has considered this type of application since 2011/12.

Of the eight applications reviewed by ECART in 2023/24, six were approved and two were approved with recommendations.

Of the 30 currently approved applications of this type there have been five live births in 2023/2024. These births are associated with applications that were approved by ECART in 2020 (1), 2021 (1), and 2022 (3).

Since 2011/12, there have been a total of 58 live births from approved applications for the creation and use, for reproductive purposes, of an embryo created from donated eggs in conjunction with donated sperm.

Surrogacy arrangements involving providers of fertility services

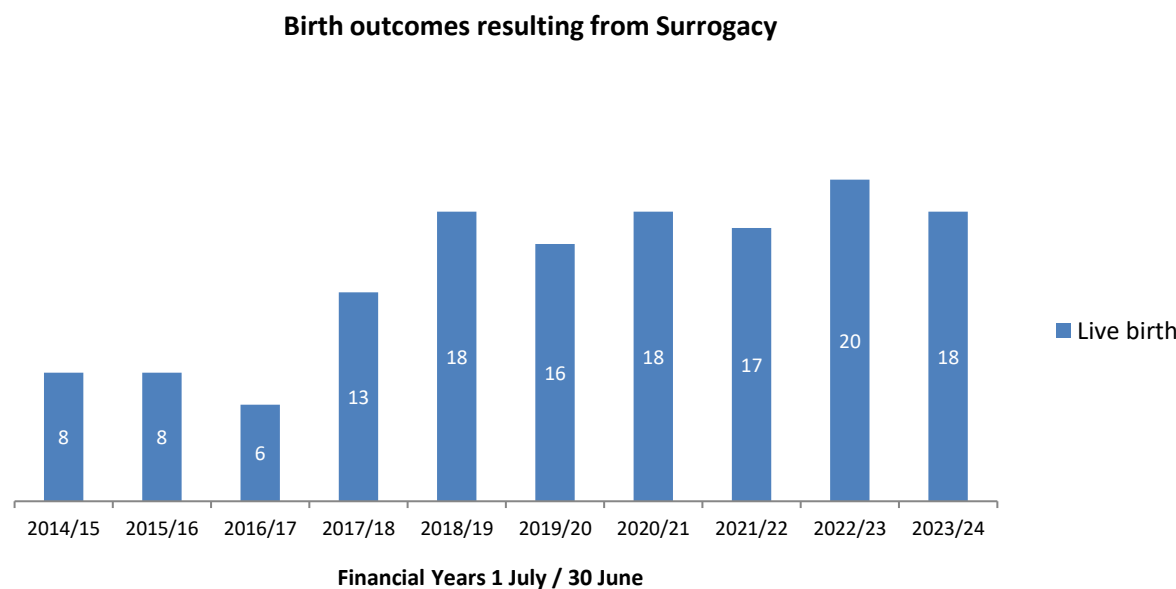
In 2023/2024, ECART reviewed 28 applications for surrogacy arrangements involving providers of fertility services.

As of 1 July 2024, six of the 28 surrogacy applications received by ECART in 2023/2024 were approved at first review, six applications were approved subject to conditions, 13 were approved with recommendations, and three were deferred. Of the deferred applications, two were approved on second review and one had no outcome as of 1 July 2024.

Of the 121 currently approved surrogacy applications there were 18 live births during 2023/2024. These births are associated with applications that were approved by ECART in 2022 (15) and 2023 (3).

Since 2005, there have been a total of 188 live births from approved applications for surrogacy.

Donation of eggs or sperm between certain family members

In 2023/2024, ECART reviewed 10 applications for the donation of eggs or sperm between family members.

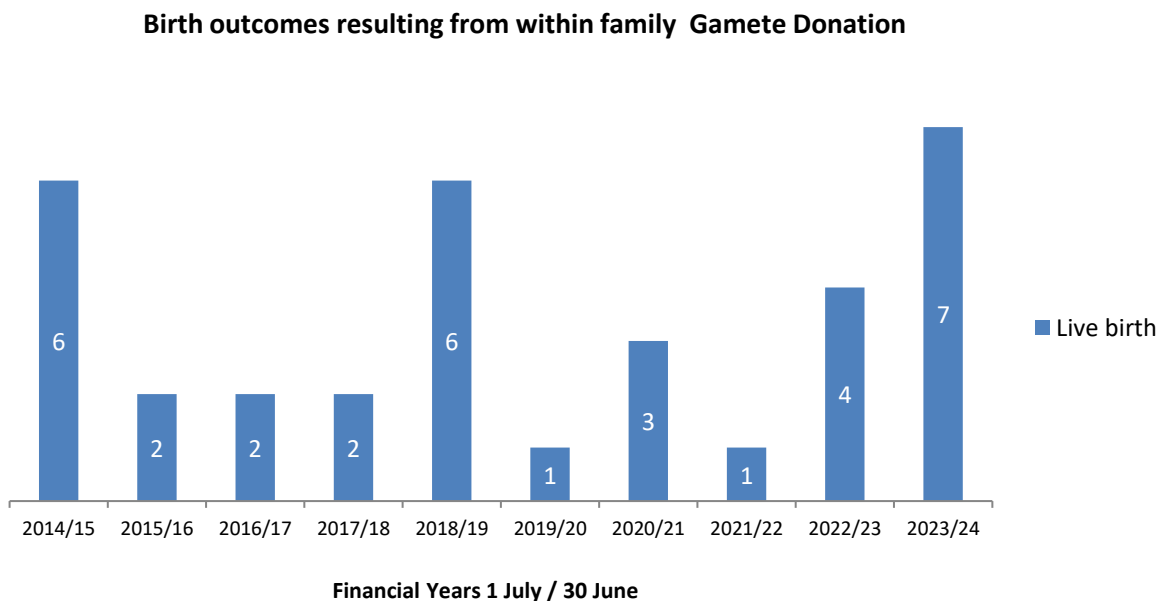
As of 1 July 2024, eight applications were approved, one was approved with recommendations and one was declined on the basis that ECART was not satisfied that the reason for the intended donation met the ‘best or only’ guideline threshold, clinically.

One of the approved applications was a request for an extension to a previously approved application.

Of the 30 currently approved applications of this type, there were seven live births during 2023/2024. These births are associated with applications that were approved by ECART in 2021 (2) and 2022 (5).

Since 2005, there have been a total of 77 live births from approved applications for the donation of eggs and sperm between family members.

Embryo donation for reproductive purposes

ECART reviewed 13 applications involving embryo donation for reproductive purposes in 2023/2024.

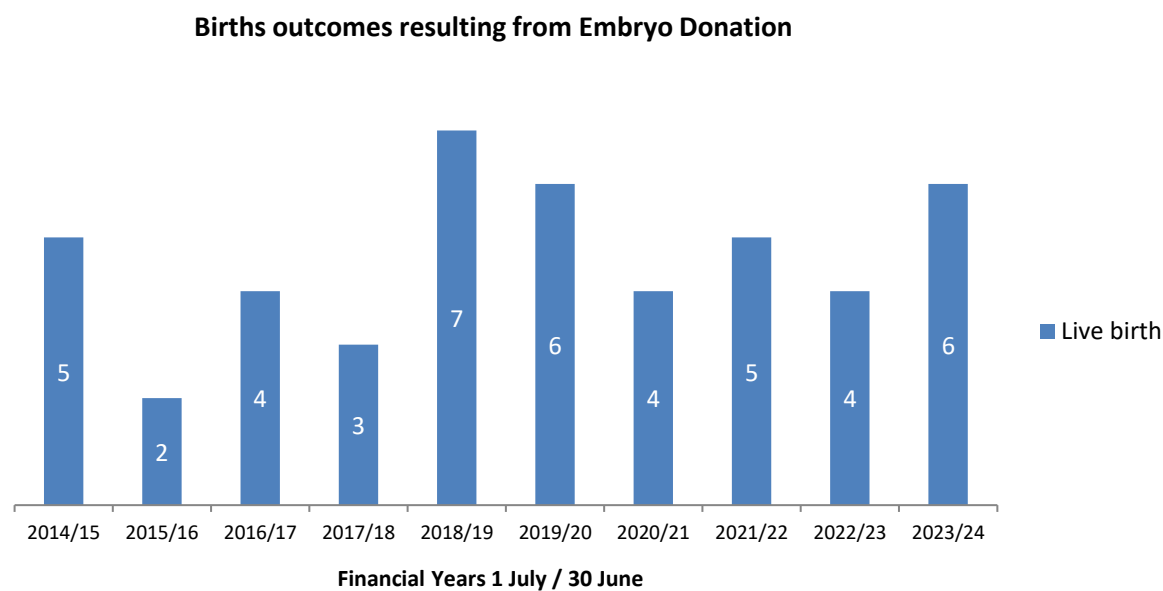
As of 1 July 2024, eight applications were approved, one was approved subject to conditions, and four applications were approved with recommendations.

One application was a request for an extension to a previously approved application.

Of the 42 currently approved applications for embryo donation there were six live births during 2023/2024. These births are associated with applications that were approved by ECART in 2020 (1), 2021 (1), 2022 (3), and 2023 (1).

Since 2005, there have been a total of 73 live births from approved applications for embryo donation.

Figure 5: Birth outcomes for applications from Embryo donation, by year, 2014/15 – 2023/24



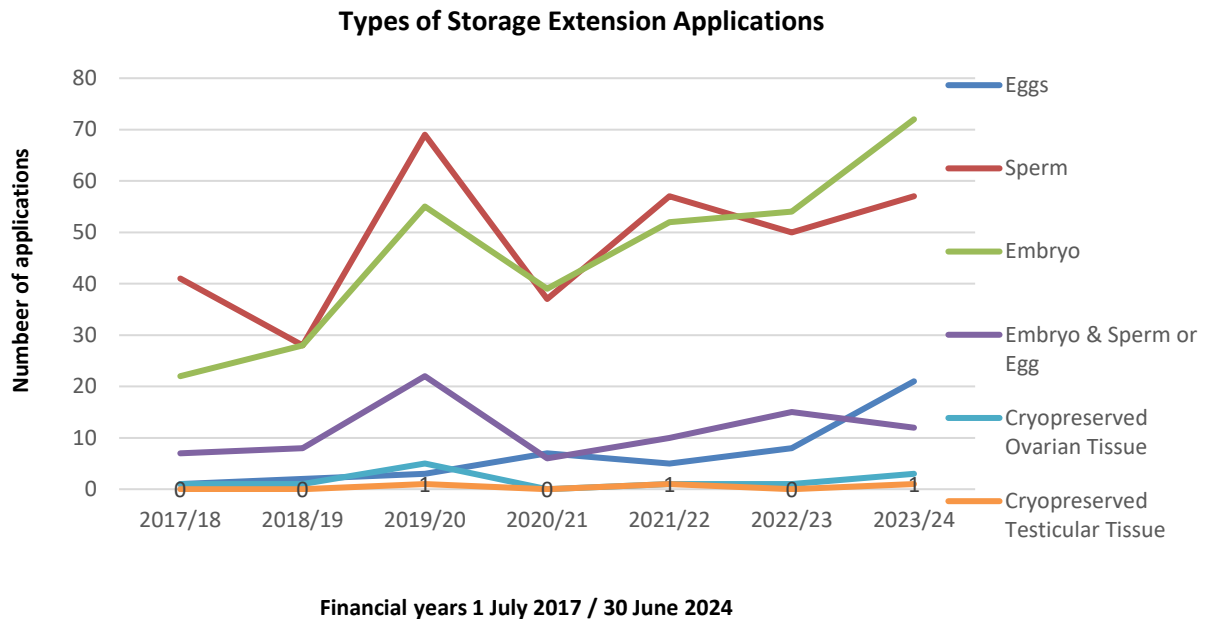
Storage Extension Applications

This year ECART considered 166 storage extension applications.

At the first review 165 applications were approved and one was declined.

The declined application was for an extension to the storage of sperm. It was declined on the basis that the HART Act does not allow ECART to approve applications which are received after their storage expiry date.

Issues and complaints

This section outlines issues faced by the Committee during 2023/2024

Advice on established procedures

In February 2011, the Minister assigned ECART the function of giving ethical advice on established procedures to fertility clinics when requested by them to do so.

ECART considered one such request relating to the transfer of embryos known to be affected by an autosomal dominant condition following PGT-M that was performed to identify healthy embryos for transfer. ECART's advice outlined the relevant considerations under the HART Act regarding the transfer of embryos with a known genetic mutation with reference to the principles contained in the Act. ECART's advice noted that the Committee's remit does not extend to giving prescriptive advice on specific clinical cases.

Issues referred to ACART

On occasion ECART has received applications to extend storage of reproductive tissue that, due to administrative error, have been submitted out of time. In such cases ECART is not authorised to approve extended storage. ECART continued to raise concerns about the difficulty that section 10A(1) of the HART Act creates for the Committee and for applicants. The Act does not allow ECART to consider and approve applications for extensions to storage where the applicable period has expired. ECART noted its view that this leads to unjust outcomes with significant and disproportionate implications for applicants who submit late applications.

ECART also raised the issue of section 10 of the HART Act not providing a mechanism for ECART to take into account the storage period (beyond an initial 10-year storage period), of gametes and embryos that have been previously lawfully stored in another jurisdiction. This creates difficulty for people who have had their reproductive material stored overseas and who are now considering importing that material for their use in fertility treatment in New Zealand.

ECART noted its view that a change to the law is required to allow ECART the discretion to consider applications for extension of storage received out of time and for applicants who have stored gametes overseas but are now living in New Zealand.

Complaints received

ECART did not receive any complaints during 2023/2024.
